

ALL IQAC MEMBERS MEET

A meeting of all the members of IQAC Committee was held in the Conference Room on August 21, 2018 at 2:30 P.M. Dr. Yamini Sharma elaborated the working and initiatives to be taken by IQAC. All members were welcomed by Dr. Anil Kumar, which was followed by an introduction about the College by Sri O.N. Bhargava, Managing Secretary of the College. A presentation was made by Dr. Sheila Srivastava elaborating the present status of the College in the context of students (enrolment, result, scholarship etc.), teachers and activities taking place in the College. She also put forth the plan of action for the year 2018-19 and invited suggestions from the Academicians, Stake holders, members of society etc. present as members of IQAC.

Various suggestions made can be enumerated as follows : -

1. Research publications by faculty and research scholars to be put up on the website.
2. An innovation cell should be formed to discuss and implement the innovative ideas (regarding teaching, research etc.) from the students and faculty members.
3. Academic Audit by all departments in which Science Departments may conduct audit for the Humanities Department or Commerce Department and vice-versa.
4. Online ICT based transparent system for evaluation and feedback should be adopted.
5. Each and every activity taking place in the College may be portrayed on the website.

6. Details of Research projects, Research papers published, Conferences attended and organized should be updated on the College website.
7. Student satisfaction survey should be conducted and evaluated periodically. A record of the phone number and Email id's of students should be maintained.
8. Incentive, in the form of cash/certificate, may be given to faculty members and research scholars for publishing research paper, participating and presenting papers in National/International Conferences.
9. A pre-admission counseling may be done for students seeking admission at UG/PG Levels.
10. Online feedback of students regarding teaching techniques/ teachers/faculty.
11. Students and faculty may be inspired through various activities like lectures on work done by Nobel Laureates etc.
12. A periodic analysis of the feedback from students should be made and modifications/improvements made accordingly.
13. Entrepreneurship programmes should be organized for students and faculty members.
14. Scheme should be initiated in which senior students may be asked to teach/help the junior students.
15. Proper co-ordination should be ensured between the teaching and non-teaching staff.

16. Teaching may be made more interesting and appealing through skits/drama etc.
17. Parent-teacher meeting may be introduced.
18. Educational tours may be conducted for UG/PG students.
19. Research may be conducted on student activities and papers published.
20. Scope for improvement in all fields should be explored.
